 - ◇ Work individually to develop a hands-on activity related to your current work. Ample concept development and materials support are provided by PSC. (Individual meetings are scheduled as needed.)
 - ◇ Prototype of your hands-on activity: Wednesday, October 28th, 1:00pm-4:00pm.
- ALL Participants are required to appear at our Meet A Scientist weekend, November 21st & 22nd, 11:30pm-4:30pm. Scientists are working with general public at this event.
